The Duke Ellington Band performed live at the Chicago Stadium, Chicago, Illinois on Friday August 7, 1959 and twice on Saturday 8th. Only billed to perform on the Saturday matinee, he seems to have opened the festival and played 3 sets on Friday night and on Saturday afternoon and evening.
