# Duke Ellington AND HIS MEN

**concertos, showcases and features 1938 / 1957** « Music is my mistress », aimait à dire sans doute le plus fécond des compositeurs américains, Duke Ellington. Et les témoignages éclatants de cette liaison inaltérable de plus de cinquante ans ne manquent pas, que ce soit sous forme de musique composée (de simples thèmes jusqu'à d'ambitieuses suites) ou de musique interprétée par le maestro et sa superbe phalange au studio ou sur la scène. Ellington, qui avait un flair – ou plutôt une oreille – infaillible pour débusquer le musicien qui allait le mieux servir sa musique avait aussi ce don unique de favoriser son épanouissement, voire de susciter son talent. Au fil des années, l'agrégation ducale aura servi d'incubateur et de révélateur à un nombre imposant de solistes, pour lesquels l'attachement du leader était tel qu'il alla jusqu'à leur concocter des « mini-concertos » pour les mettre en valeur. C'est un florilège de ces petits chefs-d'œuvre méconnus, pour la plupart captés hors des studios officiels au cours des années trente, quarante et cinquante, que nous nous sommes attachés à présenter.
