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ADAZZHOUR WITH

DUKE ELLINGTON

The American pianist, composer and bandleader Edward Kennedy 'Duke' Ellington (1899-1974) occupied a special position in jazz. As he might have said of himself, he was 'beyond category'. It was intended at first that Ellington should become a painter. and he studied for a time at the Pratt Institute in New York. But owing to lack of money he had to abandon his art studies, and he took a job as a pianist in a small café, where he also wrote his first compositions. About 1919 Ellington formed a band with some school friends, and three years later he was taken into Wilbur Sweatman's band in New York. In 1923, however, Duke Ellington became the leader of his own band, and after playing at various Harlem night clubs, he won an engagement at the famous Cotton Club in 1927. In the course of four years there the band became world-famous thanks largely to Ellington's ability for getting the best out of his brilliant musicians. To interpret music Ellington employed musicians of great individuality, allowing them considerable scope and writing in sections specifically for their unique talents. Soloists such as Johnny Hodges, Cootie Williams, Ben Webster, Lawrence Brown, Juan Tizol and Rex Stewart were to become houshold names due to their close association with

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the Duke's music.

'The music of my race', Ellington has said, 'is more than an American form of expression. What we Negroes did not dare to say openly, we said in music, and what we call jazz is something more than mere dance music.' Constant Lambert has described Ellington as 'the first jazz composer of distinction'.

Duke Ellington's first big hit in the popular music field was *Mood Indigo*, first recorded in 1930. His biggest hits in later years included *Solitude*, *Sophisticated Lady*, *Things Ain't What They Used To Be*, *Satin Doll* and *Take The A-Train*, which became the band's theme song.

The royalties from works such as these enabled him to compose and record less commercial music and he was the first jazz composer to write extended works such as *Creole Rhapsody, Black, Brown And Beige, Deep South Suite, Harlem Suite* and *Such Sweet Thunder.*

In showing to what heights a large jazz orchestra could aspire, Duke Ellington achieved a reputation not likely to be duplicated or forgotten. In the late Fifties it was clear that he had made a more extensive and more important contribution than had any other figure in the history of jazz.
